

**** PSA Please Read ****

To anyone looking to find a place for a stray dog that has come into your care, you found, or that does not otherwise belong to you.

We can NOT take in any stray animals per our license with the Department of Agriculture.

It has nothing to do with you personally or the animal in question. It is our legal obligation to direct you to the local county shelter so that the animal can wait out the mandatory stray hold in case an owner wants to come forward to claim. Once that stray hold is up (3-14 days) any rescue can pull the animal from the shelter or the animal can be adopted.

The proper steps must be taken to make sure animals with homes are given a chance to get back to them if they are not microchipped or have no identification on.

Also, as a rescue we must have the proper documentation on file to make sure we can continue to save lives without that we can lose our license and the whole rescue and our ability to save lives will be lost.
